

ARCHERY SAFETY RULES

- 1) Be aware of your situation and surroundings at all times. Coordinate your activities with other shooters. Communicate for safety.
- 2) Do not shoot when there is someone within 45 degrees of your shooting line to the bag. Gardeners are sometimes too close. Wait for them or move to the longer-range bags.
- 3) Do not approach target bags until all others have stopped shooting regardless of what target they are using.
- 4) Shoot from behind the gravel line. If you are alone on the range, you may advance closer to the target if necessary. As soon as another archer is present, you must move back to the standard shooting line.
- 5) No running with arrows or other equipment.
- 6) Keep track of your arrows. Be considerate of others waiting when searching for arrows.
- 7) Do not abuse club equipment.

ARCHERY RANGE & 3D COURSE RULES

- 1) The Archery Range has a both a standing target bag range and a 3D target course.
- 2) The perennial schedule for the 3D courses is as follows:
 - The 3D courses open in the early- to mid-Spring and close in late Summer or early Fall.
 - The 3D Range is open to non-Archery Range Officers (club members and public) on scheduled weekdays and weekends and only with an Archery Range Officer is on duty. (See the 3D Schedule on this site for specific dates.)
 - The 3D Range is open to Archery Range Officers Monday – Sunday.
- 3) The target bag range is open to members & their escorted guests year-round.
- 4) Broadheads and crossbows are only permitted on the targets marked “Broadhead” found to the right of the practice butts at the 20 and 30 yard distances. Broadheads and crossbows are NOT to be used on any standing target bags or 3D targets.
- 5) Applicable fees apply for both the standing target bag range and a 3D target course.
- 6) Hours of operation are sunrise to sunset.
