Farm Report

The Farm Committee manages nine fields which total 84.5 acres, plus a 3 acre orchard. Fields are typically planted as follows.

Description of crops

Sunflower/Wildlife seed mix = Sunflowers, Corn, Cow Pea, Sun Hemp and Sorghum Sedan Grass

Pollinator/Wildlife mix = Sunflowers, White, Red and Yellow Clovers, Buckwheat, Cowpeas, Soybeans and Sun Hemp

Unplanted meadow areas typically include: Ironweed, Indian Grass, Goldenrod, Tickseed Sunflower, Blue Mistflower, Milkweed, Black Eyed Susan and Red Clover

The Wildflower Field is the Chapter's Monarch Butterfly Waystation. The main plant here is milkweed. It provides habitat for Monarch Caterpillars. In addition this field contains Indian Grass, Little Bluestem Grass, Black Eyed Susan and Pokeweed.
